

Your Rights and Responsibilities at CREATE



CREATE Foundation is committed to making sure everyone we work with, including children and young people with a care experience, feels safe, supported, and respected.

Your Rights

When you engage with CREATE, you have the right to:

- **Feel safe and supported.** CREATE will make sure you feel physically, emotionally, and socially safe when taking part in CREATE programs and activities.
- **Be treated with respect.** Your views, experiences, and identity will be acknowledged, valued, and treated with respect.
- **Be informed.** You will be given clear information about CREATE's programs and activities, as well as how your information is used and stored, and what your rights as a young person with a care experience.
- **Have a voice.** You can speak up anytime if something doesn't feel right or if you need support. We will listen to you and take your concerns seriously.
- **Access support.** If you need help in understanding your rights, or to take part in our programs and activities safely, CREATE will offer guidance and support to help you do so.

These rights are guided by the **United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)**, which recognises every young person's right to be safe, heard, and supported.

Your Responsibilities

As a young person taking part in CREATE's programs and activities, you also have a role in helping to make CREATE a safe and respectful space for everyone.

Your responsibilities include:

- **Be respectful.** Treat other young people, staff, and volunteers with kindness and respect.
- **Speak up early.** Let CREATE staff know if something is making it hard for you or someone else to join in safely.
- **Looking after yourself and others.** Help keep activities positive and safe by following staff advice and supporting those around you.
- **Participating positively.** Join in and contribute in ways that help everyone enjoy and get the most out of CREATE programs.

By working together, we can make sure CREATE is a space where young people feel safe, supported, and empowered.
