Feel Safe

We want you to feel physically, emotionally, and socially safe at CREATE activities and programs.



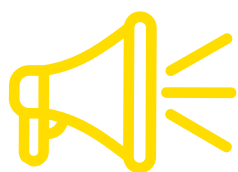
Be Heard

Your voice, experiences, and ideas matter.



Be Respected

You will be treated with kindness, dignity, and respect.



Speak Up

If something doesn't feel right, you can talk to us and we will listen.



Get Support

We will support you to safely participate in our programs and activities.



Be Informed

We will give you clear information about taking part in CREATE, how we use and protect your information, and your rights.

Your Responsibilities

We all play a part in making CREATE a safe and welcoming space



Be Respectful

Treat others with kindness and respect.



Speak Up Early

Let staff know if something is making you or someone else feel unsafe or uncomfortable.



Look Out for Others

Help keep CREATE activities safe, positive, and inclusive.



Participate Positively

Join in respectfully and help everyone feel welcome.
