

CREATE Foundation is the peak consumer body for children and young people with a care experience. We are national with offices in each state and territory with two regional offices (Newcastle, NSW and Alice Springs, NT). We represent the voices of over 40,000 children and young people currently in care, and those who have transitioned from care up to the age of 25.

The CREATE Foundation's 2015-2017 Strategic Plan commits us to building a sustainable future whilst delivering positive outcomes for children and young people.

Our strategy plays homage to our unique history and focuses on building the strength of our brand and reputation. The way forward sees us continuing to focus on building our relationships with key decision makers and researchers to influence public policy.

COMMITMENT TO ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE



CREATE Foundation recognises that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are the traditional custodians of Australia and we acknowledge the unique relationship that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders have with the land and seas. CREATE supports a unified Australia where respect for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders is afforded, and aligned with the Vision of the Council of Aboriginal Reconciliation that purports justice and equity for all.

CREATE Foundation respects the rights of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to maintain their culture and to be involved and participate in decisions that affect their lives and future.

Our commitment to improving the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people through our actions and behaviours is embedded throughout our strategic plan and includes three focus areas: relationships, opportunities and respect.

Goal: Reach out to every child and young person with a care experience

Improve regional services to children and young people.

Broaden our contemporary communication platforms to connect children and young people to each other and to CREATE.

Build stronger relationships that facilitate connections within communities.

Connect children and young people to CREATE with emphasis given to providing opportunities for engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people who are over represented in the system.

> Deliver empowerment programs that are accessible and culturally relevant for all children and young people including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and those from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

> > Build self-confidence/esteem to facilitate the voices of children and young people aged between 8 – 14 years.

Goal: Increase the participation of children and young people in empowerment programs.

Extend CREATE empowerment programs and initiatives into regional areas.

Support the leadership, life skill development and financial well-being of young people.

change

- Improve outcomes for children and young people with a care experience.
- Government and sector decision makers are aware of CREATE and the role we play in promoting the voices of children and young people.

Engage children and young people to develop an evidence base to inform CREATE's advocacy work.

> Promote tolerance and reduce the stigma associated with children and young people with a care experience through awareness campaigns.

Address the over representation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people within the care system.

Advocate in the sector to achieve increased positive outcomes for young people transitioning from care.

Act as a critical friend to government.

Advocate for all children and young people to have the opportunity to be able to participate and have a say about things that are important to them.

> Consolidate CREATE's position as a well-known and respected leader in the child protection sector.
