



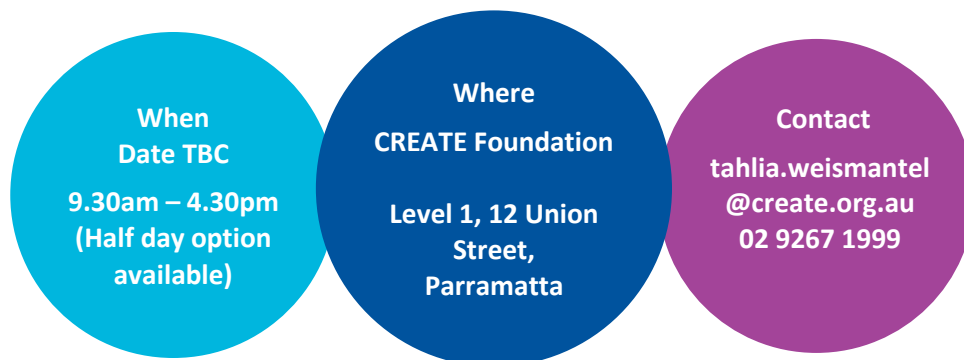
Volunteering at CREATE Foundation

Not creative? No problem! You can write an inspirational message to young people 17 – 25 years of age. We provide stickers, stencils, textas, crayons and colouring in pencils. It's a great way to tap into your creative side and relive your childhood.

Tea, Coffee and Lollies will be provided throughout the day. Feel free to bring stickers, stamps, and glitter to decorate the birthday cards. We ask for energy, enthusiasm, and a sense of fun for a day spent helping to improve the lives of children and young people in care!

Please note that CREATE is a child safe organisation, requiring all candidates to be screened for suitability to work with children and young people. You will be required to submit to a police check 2 weeks prior to your volunteering date. You will not need a police check if you are able to provide details of your valid Working With Children Check.
