

National Influencing Committee Member Nomination Pack

- Are you aged 15-25 years, and have completed CREATE's Speak Up Program (SUP) Level 3?
- Do you work well in a team?
- Do you want to speak up and have your voice heard to help CREATE make the out-of-home care system for the better for all children and young people?

If you answered YES to the above, why don't you nominate yourself for appointment as a member of our National Influencing Committee?

The purpose of the Influencing Committee to draw together CREATE's Policy and Advocacy and Marketing team to develop and implement key strategies for promoting CREATE's advocacy agenda as outlined in the Strategic Plan. The Influencing Committee will source information from states and also be responsible for circulating its progress across the organisation.

There are <u>two</u> positions for young people on the Influencing Committee, and young people can nominate themselves using this Application Form. Young people must identify two suitable referees (people who can support their application and suitability for the role). Additionally, the State Coordinator must support the application.

All applications will be considered, and the Influencing Committee Members will shortlist applicants and offer them an opportunity to have a chat about their application through an interview.

Influencing Committee responsibilities will include:

- Attend monthly Influencing Committee Meetings (the first will be face to face) and the others if young people are not Qld based will be over the phone;
- Read the material for the Influencing Committee meeting in advance of the meeting and discuss any questions within the agenda for young people (with a member of the Influencing Committee) prior to the meeting;
- Contribute to the Influencing Committee meeting and provide your opinions, and perspective about a range of topics related to the National Influencing Strategy and actively participate in the meetings.

If you are under 18 you must discuss your nomination with your parent, guardian, carer or case worker and have them sign the form.

INTERESTED? – Then all you need to do now is apply. Check out the eligibility (what you need to have to apply) fill out the attached Application Form and return it to the CREATE office by **30 March, 2020**. If you need help filling out the form you can ask for help from anyone you choose.

All applicants need to have the following to be eligible to apply

- Be between 15 25 years of age
- Have an out of home care experience
- Completed Speak Up Training (SUP) Level 3
- Be a clubCREATE member
- Been an active participant in the state/territory Youth Advisory Groups and state activities
- Willing to commit to being an active Influencing Committee Member for six months

- Willing to engage with other children and young people in care, to adequately represent their views
- Able to work constructively in a group/team.
- Possess good communication skills.

Payment

For the first meeting, we will invite the two successful applicants to attend the meeting in Brisbane in person. Cost of flights and where essential accommodation will be met by CREATE for this first face to face meeting. If you are under 18 you will require an adult to travel with you. Unfortunately, CREATE cannot cover the cost for this person. However, options may exist with agencies to support the carer/case worker to attend.

Young people are expected to attend monthly meetings for approximately 1 hour. CREATE will cover 2 hours pre reading and preparation, 2 hours for the meeting day and 1 hour for post meeting follow up = 5 hours per month. This will be reviewed after six months.

CREATE will reimburse young people for their time at the current Youth Facilitator rate of pay (which is slightly different in each state).
