- I get a lot of attention from my caseworker (M, 16)
- Caseworkers make time for me (F, 19)
- When they care (F, 23)
- They listen, praise me, and tell me I'm doing a good job (F, 25)
- My case manager gets to know me and actually care and wants the best for me and my future (F, 20)

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In our craft YAG online, we had craft packs delivered to young people's doors and chatted about what peoples different creative outlets were. This is what they said:

- "Cooking" (F, 25)
- "Doing lego" (M, 16)
- "I sing and I also paint" (F, 20)
- "To get my creative side I like to get paints and a paint board and just splat them" (F, 18)
- "I like drawing " (M, 12)
- "I do art in my classes and do canvassing."
- "I'm doing scrapbooking" (F, 25)
- "I tried scrap booking but it didn't work out" (F, 20)
- "My Cw got me to do an identity book, when I was close to 18... I loved it. It made me look deep into myself to look into who I thought I was and what was important to me and got to do it in a creative outlet like this" (F. 20)
