There was a range of decision makers such as Pam Barker, CEO of Yfoundation, Katherine McKarnan, CEO of homelessness NSW, Zoe from the Advocate and our very own CREATE CEO Jacqui Reed. There was also a range of ministers present such as the Honorable Minister Ward, Honorable Minister Penny Sharpe. There will be many more guest speakers announced, so keep an eye out!

What a great way for the young people of CREATE to have an opportunity to meet, have your voice heard and enquire about important issues within the care sector such as youth homelessness, youth participation, extending care and mental health, life skills, youth actions and more.

As we do more events online, we would feel your love through the screen. Young people shared their appreciation for the Youth Advisory Groups, and one stated to that the group was the "best friend they have ever met".

Our Speak Up program is a 3 module workshop that focus on communication and leadership training. It equips young people with the skills to Speak Up for themselves and other young people to advocate for positive change in the system.

Over the last few months, a group of young people joined us to share their experiences and learnt effective ways to communicate and advocate.

To say that learning is done only from one side is a lie. We learnt so much from the young people, their experience, resilience and courage to speak up despite circumstances inspire us all.

At CREATE we have a culture of acceptance embedded in our Child Safe standards. This enable a young person to share their story for the first time ever to anyone outside of their situation. It is these acts of courage from young people that are crucial to creating change in the system.

At the end of October we announced seven new, highly capable Young Consultants. Watch this space as they will be embarking on a journey with us over the next few years to advocate for change. I am sure you will be seeing a lot more of them in the future!



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# WATCH OUT FOR OUR UPCOMING ADVOCACY

#### **CECT** webinar

Intensive Therapeutic Care (ITC) is a service system that helps children and young people who are recovering from trauma. ITC is for children and young people over 12 years and aims to provide intensive supports to maintain stability in living arrangements.

The ITC system, which replaced residential care across NSW from 1 July 2017, is now due for a review!

So, what is better than getting it from the experts? The young people themselves with lived experience to share with us what is working and what is not working.

At CREATE, we strive for continuous improvement and this is no different.

#### Children in Care Collective Forum (CCC)

Three NSW Young Consultants will have the opportunity to facilitate at the forum, focusing on the health and wellbeing of children and young people in OOHC.

The outcome is to develop recommendations and/or actions that can be taken to address the concerns of, and difficulties experienced by, children and young people in OOHC.







### We have been ramping things up here in NSW!

Utilising the current climate and government attention, we have been shining a spotlight on some of the issues in the care system and provide a wide range of platform for CREATE young consultant to advocate directly.

We held a meet and greet with Minister Sharpe - she is the Shadow Minister for Family and Community Services, and Disability Inclusion, as well as Minister Ward, who is the Minister for Child Protection

Our Young Consultants had the opportunity to directly share their views, experience and advocate for issues that are close to their heart.

For Child Protection Week - our Young Consultant Taya represented CREATE as a guest panel specialist on the Office of Children's Guardian (OCG) panel discussion. She did a spectacular job representing the voice of young people in care, asking organisations to ensure greater meaningful participation of children voices in decision affecting them and consideration for young people individual equity and diverse needs. With thousands of people in attendance, Taya's voice has created massive impact in multiple organisations and in the lives of young people in care.

We just want to give a shout out to our Young Consultants who have been working closely with us over the last couple of months to advocate. We cannot do any of this without you.
