clubCREATE	clubCREATE is an exclusive club for children and young people aged 0 to 25 who are in care or have a care experience. It connects children and young people together and links them to CREATE programs and services nationally. We create quartlerly magazines, run connection events and provide opportunities for children and young people to have their say. Speak Up	Speak Up (SUP) is a three-level training program for young people aged 14 to 25 who want to become a CREATE Young Consultant. Participants learn about the care system and develop advocacy, leadership and public speaking skills. Young Consultants use their stories and experiences to represent CREATE at local, state or national events and forums. CREATE Your Future	The CREATE Your Future (CYF) program supports young people aged 15 -25 on their transition from care to independence. The life skills required to effectively manage the challenges of everyday life are broad and translating knowledge, attitude and values into abilities that enable young people to excel is the foundation of this program. We also have an app, Sortli, designed to help young people leaving care. YAGs	Youth Advisory Groups are forums for children and young people aged 10 to 25 to meet regularly, usually at a fun activity, to discuss issues they are facing within the care system. They can also provide input into resource development, programs and general government or organisational policy. Research

Consultations

We listen to ideas from children and young people about their experiences in all forms of out-of-home care and share those views with people who run the care system. We use this consultation information children and young people share with us to advocate for change in the system through reports, submissions and position papers.

Reports

One of the ways that CREATE helps to create a better life for children and young people in care is by informing the community and governments about the views of children and young people on their care experiences.

Our reports come from research projects and provide a picture of how well the child protection system is functioning for children and young people in out-of-home care.

Example 1

2018 Report

In 2018, CREATE conducted the largest ever independent survey of children and young people with a care experience, surveying 1275 children and young people about their experiences in the outof-home care system.



Example 2

2013 Report

This report highlights the need for care systems to focus on the things that matter, including things such as: caseworker relationships, education, health, relationships with family and siblings, and future planning.
