
Well, it's been a great 3 months.

We have been working with ACT Together's CAP program and Child and Youth Protection Services with a special COVID program that has been assisting young people who have left care and may have been financially impacted by COVID-19.

This has been a great initiative as we have seen many young people get some extra help with all kinds of things. We have a few young people that have had courses, clothes, gym memberships and classes provided just to name some examples!

This time throughout the pandemic has been interesting, but there's opportunity to give things a go. If you have recently left care and need assistance you can talk to us at CREATE or after care support at ACT Together.
