Have you heard about Viewpoint?

It is an online survey you can do to let the Department know how you're going and what you need.

We are so excited to announce that Viewpoint can now be used!

With the help of Youth Change Makers, the questions are ready. Lots of Child Safety Officers have begun showing children and young people how to log in and use Viewpoint. Each Viewpoint has questions about the 6 areas of wellbeing to check that you are ok and what you need.

The 6 areas are:

- Being loved and safe
- Having the things you need
- Participating
- Learning
- Culture and identity
- Being healthy

Did you know there are two different Viewpoints? The first is for 5-11 year old children and the second is for 12-17 year old young people in care.

Would you like to try it? Ask your Child Safety Officer now!

Seeing that not every child had the opportunity to go to school, or to have the experiences that I do, was heartbreaking. you, as long as you put your mind to it! I personally never thought I'd be able to have this experience, but with hard work and going through the steps I was able to go.
